



Bolsover District Council (Langwith and Whaley Thorns) Public Spaces Protection Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Bolsover District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order pursuant to s 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") after undertaking consultation as required by Section 72 of the Act.

The Council is satisfied that it is likely that activities will be carried out in the Restricted Area that will have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality. The Council is further satisfied that the effect of these activities is likely to be of a persistent and continuing nature, and is of such as to make the activities unreasonable and the effect of the activities justifies the restrictions imposed.

This Order may be cited at the Langwith and Whaley Thorns Public Space Protection Order 2019 and takes effect from XXXX and remains in place for a period of 3 years.

Provisions

1. The land described by the Map in Schedule 1, edged in red, being the land in the area of the Council is land to which the Act applies to and is protected by the Order (herein called the "Restricted Area")
2. Any person who does not comply with any obligations imposed by this order in the Restricted Area shall be guilty of an offence under section 67 of the Act and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.
3. The following prohibitions are imposed on use of the Restricted Area;
 - a. No person shall have unsealed vessels containing alcohol in their possession;
 - b. No person shall urinate, defecate or spit in any public place
 - c. No person shall dispose of any litter other than in the bins provided;
 - d. No persons shall make excessive noise which causes nuisance or Anti-social behaviour
 - e. It shall be an offence if a person fails to comply immediately with a direction from a constable or Authorised Person to move on from land within the Restricted Area.
4. In this order Authorised Person means an employee of the Authority who is authorised in writing by the Council for the purposes of the order and a Police Community Support Officer.
